BRC Course Information

The primary goal of the *Basic Rider Course* is to introduce the rider to the fundamentals of safe motorcycle operation.

This 15 hour course is broken into approximately five hours of classroom time and ten hours of on motorcycle instruction, with motorcycles provided for all participants.

Successful completion of this course may be used in place of the Motorcycle Operator skills test administered by the Motor Vehicle Commission.

To participate in the course, students must have a validated motorcycle learners permit issued by a full service MVC. (This includes a vision and knowledge test.) To qualify for the NJMVC riding test waiver student must possess a valid auto license. The students must also have the ability to ride a bicycle and, if under the age of 18, have written parental consent.

ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE GEAR :

- Over the ankle boots or shoes
- Long Pants
- Full Fingered Gloves
- Helmet (provided or use your own)
- Eye protection (Glasses or sunglasses)
- Rain Gear

TUITION

There is a *\$295 fee, for the *Basic Rider Course*. Tuition can be paid by Visa, MasterCard, cash, check or money order.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Students are not guaranteed that they will pass the class. Students must meet all requirements and pass all evaluations to receive a motorcycle license.
- Students must have taken the written and eye test at MVC and have a validated permit prior to registering for the course.
- To qualify for the NJMVC riding test waiver students must possess a valid auto drivers license.
- In order to successfully complete this course the student must attend all sessions and complete a written and skill evaluation
- Once registered, any change requested by the student will result in a **\$50 reschedule fee** and must be submitted five days prior to the course date.
- There are **no refunds** unless a class is cancelled.
- Rain dates are for severe weather. **Classes are conducted in the rain** and require appropriate attire.
- Students may request an oral exam versus a written exam.
- Instructors reserve the right to remove a student from the riding portion of the course at any time (**without refund**) for safety reasons.
- **Absence or lateness** from any portion of the class will result in removal from the class **without refund**.
